

## **What are capital Credits?**

Belonging to a not-for-profit cooperative means you are a part-owner. As such, you receive a portion of margins (called capital credits). At the end of each year, expenses are subtracted from that year's operating revenues and the balance is allocated to members as capital credits. How much each member receives is based on how much power the member purchase during the year returned. It is extremely important that you continue to keep your address updated with GCEC and GCU even after you have disconnected your utilities with us, to ensure these capital credits are returned to you.
