**AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF LONG TERM FINANCING BY**  
**GRAHAM COUNTY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC**

Graham County Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Company") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an order authorizing the Company to issue up to \$8,000,000.00 (gross proceeds) of Long-Term Financing. Additionally, the Company is requesting the ability to participate in the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Rural Economic Development Loan and Grant Program, and to classify any proceeds received from its participation in that program as other Long-Term Obligations. The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the Company's main office, located at 9 West Center Street, Pima, Arizona 85543; at the Commission's Docket Control Center, located at 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona; the Commission's Tucson office, located at 400 West Congress, Suite 218, Tucson, Arizona; and on the Internet via the Commission website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov)) using the e-Docket function found on the website's homepage.

Intervention in the Commission's proceedings on the application shall be permitted if the outcome of the case will directly and substantially impact the person, and the person's intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in the case. Information about intervention and sample intervention requests are available on the Commission's website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov)) using the "I Want To Intervene In A Case" link. Persons desiring to intervene must file an original and 13 hard copies of a written request to intervene with Docket Control, located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, by no later than June 14, 2019, and send a copy of the request to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record on the same day that such persons file the request to intervene with the Commission.

Requests to Intervene must contain the following information:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor, and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made, if different than the intervenor.
2. A reference to Docket No. E-01749A-19-0108
3. A short statement explaining:
  - a. The person's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, etc.)
  - b. How the potential intervenor will be directly and substantially affected by the outcome of the case, and
  - c. Why the person's intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in the case.
4. A statement certifying that a copy of the request to intervene has been served on the utility or its attorney and all parties of record in the case, and
5. If the person is not represented by an attorney who is an active member of the Arizona State Bar, and is not representing him or herself as an individual, sufficient information and any appropriate documentation to demonstrate compliance with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, 39 and 42, as applicable.

The granting of requests to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that motions to intervene must be filed on or before June 14, 2019. If representation by counsel is required by Arizona Supreme Court Rule 31, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor.
